Memorandum The Twenty seventh day of March 1714 I doe make this Codicil and declare the same as part my last will that in case my grandchild Sarah Woodgate dye before she shall attain her age of one and twenty years then I will and give the Plate and Jewels before willed to her to come and be equally divided betwixt her three sisters or to the survivors of them share alike witness my hand and seal. I Charles Hedges of Westminster do make and ordain my last will and Testament in manner following & shew as I have lawfully upon the marriage of my son William Hedges made a provisional settlement on him of all and singular my lands leases Mannors Tenements and hereditaments in Abchurch Lane Compton and Highway and elsewhere in the County of Middlesex as by the said settlement relation being annexed thereto had more fully appeared I do hereby ratify and confirm the said settlement with all the Articles and covenants therein contained and do desire my Executor or executors after named to see the same punctually performed in all the parts thereof and whereas I have reserved power in the said settlement and covenants to charge my Estate at Compton with the sum of seven thousand pounds for a paying off the mortgages and Incumbrances upon Moorfield in the County of Middlesex to the end that the said Moorfield Estate be settled in jointure on my sons wife and issue as by

the said settlements and covenants may appear I do hereby according to the power by me reserved charge my Estate at Compton with the said sume of seven thousand pounds for the purposes aforesaid and do direct that my Executor herein after named, do levy and raise the said sume of seven thousand pounds as soon as may be after his wife is come to age and that she and M^{rs} Frances Gore her Mother and M^{rs} Mary Gore her grandmother shall have performed and executed their parts of the said marriage settlement from I give and bequeath unto my said son William Hodges whom I make my sole Executor of this my last will and Testament all my Estate real and personal whatsoever upon this condition that my wife Jane Elmer Hodges may have and retain any part of my plate and household goods in any of my houses as she shall think fit for her own use in Abitance whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fourteen.
